North Alabama Presbytery is blessed to have substantial financial resources which could and should be used in a responsible fashion to enhance and support the ministry of the presbytery and its congregations. To be faithful stewards of these funds, the Executive Commission has established a NAP Ministry Grant process which will be managed by the Business Affairs and Personnel Team. Grants will be available for use by congregations, pastors, youth and young adults, and presbytery entities to support programs and ministries which will enhance their ministries.
