





Grace joins Faith, Huntsville; Fellowship, Huntsville; First, Albertville; First, Florence; Westminster, Decatur; First, Ft. Payne; First, Cullman in celebrating how their congregation is Building Church Vitality, Dismantling Structural Racism, and Eradicating Systemic Poverty! How is your church at work in your community?

After using the Matthew 25 Bible Study from the Presbyterian Mission Agency as the devotional at the beginning of their meetings, the Session of **Grace Presbyterian** became interested in becoming a Matthew 25 Congregation. The Session wanted the congregation to know more about it before taking a vote, so Rev. Robin Palmer preached a four-week Stewardship sermon series to help the congregation learn more about the movement. The first week of Stewardship season, the sermon introduced Matthew 25, and each area of focus was the topic of the next three sermons. At their Dec. 1 meeting, the Session voted unanimously to become a Matthew 25 Congregation, with the chosen area of focus being eradicating systemic poverty. The Session realized that all three areas of focus intersect and will strive to learn more about building congregational vitality and dismantling structural racism in the future, but will begin with systemic poverty because that is an area the congregation is already involved in through the Harvest of Grace Community Garden, the St. Elizabeth CPCA food pantry, and support for Enable of Madison County as well as the Presbyterian Home for Children.
